Building Blocks Blanket

You asked for it, and now we've got it! A program that will let knitters of all levels practice and hone their skills as they produce a lovely and practical item.

The Building Blocks Blanket, a year-long class, will result in a beautiful sampler blanket and a refreshed (or maybe first) look at such techniques as cabling, lace and bobbles.

We will offer a class on the first Saturday of every month to help you over any knitting hurdles and to master new techniques. The class will be

repeated on the following Tuesdays.

The Building Blocks Blanket program also includes online tutorials to help you work on each square between classes.
