CustomFit: Our knitalong is wrapping up, but our CustomFit program continues indefinitely. The program allows you to design your own sweater or pick from a number of pre-designed sweaters. At your first appointment we will comprehensively measure you, and you can pick out your yarn and design. At your second appointment you'll return with a knitted and blocked swatch, and we'll produce a computer-generated pattern that fits you perfectly. The cost for measuring and producing your pattern is \$25. If you like the result (and you will), subsequent patterns are \$10.

We are also offering a six-week CustomFit class on Sunday mornings starting January 18.

Knitalong Features New Take on the Seamless Sweater

Our winter knitalong is the very popular Hitofude cardigan from Hiroko Fukatsu. In Japanese, Hitofude means a single brush



stroke. This open-front cardigan with an all-over lace pattern is worked in one "yarn stroke"—a continuous strand of yarn that is never cut.

The yarn stroke begins at the upper body, and creates a rectangle from the yoke and sleeves worked together. The stroke then moves to lower body, where the lace pattern increases evenly, creating a gentle drape.

More than 2200 Ravelry users have made this project, which flatters a wide variety of body types.

Our recommended yarn for the project is Madelinetosh Merino Light. Other fingeringweight yarns may be substituted. Feel free to splurge on yarn: The pattern costs less than \$2.

The knitalong kicks off January 17 with a launch party. You can get advice on yarn and pattern details, start your project, and enter to win door prizes.

Along the way you can get all the help you need, and we've scheduled several socialization and help sessions. The knitalong wraps up April 19 with another party. Come show off your finished (or almost finished) projects!

Blanket Builds Your Color-Work Skills

Want to learn more about knitting with colors? We're kicking off a year-long project aimed right at you. The Building in Color blanket consists of 10 strips, each featuring a different colorwork technique. In a series of Saturday-morning drop-in sessions, we'll feature help with a different panel each month. The blanket's designer, Michelle Hunter, has created a series of online videos to aid you in between sessions.

Our recommended yarn is Cascade 220, although many other yarns may be substituted. The blanket requires three colors.

Monthly sessions are \$10. The accompanying book, a \$20 value, is free to those purchasing



a blanket's worth of yarn during the month of January.
