Fun with Stripes: BlueSand Cardigan

I'm excited to announce our winter knitalong, the BlueSand Cardigan by La Maison Rilie. This long cozy cardigan features stripes, a bit of texture, and pockets! The pattern is knit seamlessly from the top down, and offers two options for shoulder/yoke construction.



The first option is a combination yoke version which features a fun take on yoke construction, combining various methods to achieve a soft sloping shoulder line, similar to set in sleeves. The second option is a raglan construction that is a bit of a hybrid between a saddle shoulder and a raglan sleeve. Both versions include charted and written instructions. Overall the pattern has a lot of fun techniques that will keep you engaged.

The pattern's suggested yarn is a DK weight, but a large number of projects on Ravelry have used fingering and sport weight yarns, creating a bit more drape to the sweater's fabric. Our store sample is knit in HiKoo Rylie, a baby alpaca, mulberry silk, and linen blend. The pattern is written for three colors, but we encourage you to mix it up - I've also seen some great single color versions. We'll have sheets in the shop to help you select colors and yarn.

The knitalong kicks off on Saturday, January 14th from 4 to 6 with door prizes, refreshments and lots of help available. Socialization and help sessions are set for Saturdays February 11th and March 11th from 3:30 to 4:30. The finale party is Saturday, April 29th from 5 to 6.



Basics

Learn to Knit: One 2-hour session. Get an introduction to basic terms and kinds of yarns. Learn the basic stitch and get started on your first scarf. Buy or bring supplies. \$25.
