Fall Knit Along: Lowbrow Hat and Cowl

A slight chill is returning to the air and it is definitely time to start thinking about winter projects. For our fall knit-along I've chosen the Lowbrow Cowl and Hat by Portland-based Thao Nguyen (Nerd Bird Makery).

Knit with a worsted or aran weight yarn, either the hat or cowl would be a great option for holiday gifts. Both options are knit it the round with an easy to follow charted leaf design.

We've knit up the hat in Glamour, a subtly sparkly yarn from Molly Girl Yarns (arriving soon), and the cowl in Knitted Wit's Aran.

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Sweater Society: Raglans

We had so much fun in the inaugural round of the Sweater Society and I can't wait to see what we make in the next round. This session we will focus on sweaters with a raglan construction. While there are some complex raglan pattern options, many of the more basic patterns are a great option for a first sweater.

There are lots of choices. If you need some help looking for a pattern we can help, or you can take a look at the Ravelry bundle we've put together. There are also some great options for crocheters.

A few of my favorite options are: Blank Canvas by Ysolda Teague (a great basic with thoughtful details to improve the fit); anything in Marie Green's Seamless Sweaters in 2 weeks (or many of her other sweaters); Diaphanous Raglan by Jessie Maed Designs, Ursa or Ursa Minor by Jacqueline Cieslak, Julissa by Vanessa Smith or Mailin by Isabell Kraemer.

If you want to join in the fun we will meet on September 15th, October 13th, November 10th, and December 8th from 3 to 5. (Note that the September meeting is the third Sunday; the others are all the second Sunday of the month.) Don't worry if you can't make it every time, this is a fun, informal group where you can go at your own pace.
