Summer KALs: Choose your Stripes

This summer we are offering two knit-alongs, one shawl and one garment, both featuring fun stripes. The shawl option is the Passaggio Shawl - a great use for mini-skeins or gradient kits. The other option is the Rosencrantz & Guildenstern patterns that we premiered during the recent LYS Tour.

I think many knitters have (or dream of having) that one thing you find yourself wearing over and over again. Those of you who see me around the shop often may be able to guess that, for me, it's my Passaggio Shawl designed by Mary Annarella.



Passaggio means passage in Italian and the shawl is knit in such a way that the sections seamlessly transition from one to the next. It is an extremely wearable shawl that can be worn as a wrap or, as I most often do, a squishy, slightly over-sized, scarf.

Worked as three connected triangles, the construction is simultaneously familiar and approachable, but with a fun, novel twist. The end result is a trapezoid shape that looks like a much more complex knit than it is. The garter stitch makes this a relaxing knit, and but color changes and stripes of eyelet rows keep things interesting.

The shawl is a great way to use those mini-skeins or gradient sets that are so enticing, or you could mix it up and choose a simpler look with just a few colors. Either way, the options are endless and we'll be here to help you plot your color options.

While it might not be as much fun as an Italian vacation, we hope you join us for this great summer project! The KAL kicks off Saturday June 17th. More details are on Page 3.

We love the patterns that Cory and Noriko co-designed for us to feature during the LYST. The patterns feature two different stripe/ombre options.

The ombre effect in Rosencrantz is achieved by holding different colors together. This makes it a quick knit using three different color yarns. Guildenstern uses four colors in thinner stripes for a lighter weight top and lots of stripe options!



Both patterns use Queensland United, a sport weight cotton-wool blend, perfect for Seattle weather. The yarn ins available in over 20 shades for lots of color options. The KAL kicks off Sunday June 11th. More details are on Page 3.

Knitting Basics

Learn to Knit: One 2-hour session. Get an introduction to basic terms and kinds of yarns. Learn the basic stitch and get started on your first scarf. Buy or bring supplies. \$25.

Blocking: One 2-hour session. Mystified by blocking? In this session you'll learn why you should block, how to block, and lots of tips and tricks for making your finished projects look their best. \$30

In this workshop Cory Ellen will teach you how to choose and use these beautiful yarns. The workshop will start with the basics of color theory, look at different types of variegation and gradients, and discuss what kinds of stitch patterns and design elements will make these yarns shine. \$30

Three 2-hour sessions. Scared of sweaters? Want to take your knitting to the next level? Join us to make the Spotlight Sweater by Tin Can Knits.
